Dr Mistry has acquired clinical expertise within the practice of neuropsychological assessment, formulation and intervention.

Dr Mistry is Director of Neuropsych Solutions Ltd and co-founder of the Neuro Rehab Group and provides neuropsychological assessment and intervention within the private sector and the media-legal sector as a treating clinician and expert witness. He is experienced working with adults, children and families. Dr Mistry is also skilled in working with and providing neuropsychological intervention to children. He is experienced in working directly with paediatric clients as well as working with their support network, working with families (parents and siblings), schools, as well as other professionals and agencies, to achieve the rehabilitation goal/s.
