Lucie qualified in January 2020 having completed the Occupational Therapy Pre-Registration MSc at Leeds Beckett University with Distinction. She is a member of the Royal College of Occupational Therapists (RCOT) and is registered with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC). Prior to occupational therapy Lucie acquired a BA (Honours) degree in Communication Studies at the University of Leeds, which led to a five-year career in digital marketing.

Lucie provides OT support to a neurological rehabilitation (neuro-rehab) unit in Liverpool, providing holistic occupational therapy for people with acquired brain injury (ABI) and neurological conditions. Lucie supports people in improving their function and engagement in meaningful occupation through upper limb, cognitive, sensory and vocational rehabilitation, to provide client-centred and measurable outcomes.

Her interests include dance, yoga, meditation, horticulture, creative writing and art, which she incorporates into her therapy where appropriate. She is working towards additional cognitive rehabilitation accreditation to build on the foundations of her clinical skillset.

During her Masters, Lucie worked as a support worker for those with ABI to progress her knowledge in this clinical area. Lucie's training included NHS and third-sector settings, including acute mental health, paediatrics, veterans' mental health and an intermediate neurorehab unit. Her commitment to the ABI community was highlighted and commended following her MSc research project exploring the lives, identities and occupational potential of young brain injury survivors.

Lucie is based in Didsbury, Manchester. She is supervised by Andrea Matthews, Company Director and Consultant Occupational Therapist.
